SFN ELECTION

Due to the recent public health emergency declared in Yukon in response to COVID-19, certain changes will be made to the standard election procedure to comply with physical distancing requirements.

SFN Election is postponed until May 6, 2020 – we must receive your ballot by this date for it to be counted. Those who have already mailed their ballots, they are valid and will be counted on May 6 (day of the Election)

Voting will be by **MAIL-IN BALLOTS ONLY**

Ballots will be mailed to Whitehorse and Pelly Crossing Citizens as soon as possible. All other Citizens outside of these two communities were already mailed ballots and they are still valid so please cast your vote on them.
