Job Summary:

The position is located in the Pelly Crossing and reports to the Yukon Government, Tatchun Wildland Fire Management, Regional Protection Manager, Regional Duty Officer, or Incident Commander when assigned, and to the Office Manager at Selkirk Development Corporation. The Crew Leader may be required to travel from the home base for periods up to 19 days, with a possibility of a 1-week extension to other Yukon Fires, and/or fires outside of the Territory.

The Crew Leader is directly responsible for supervising and safely directing the activities of the Initial Attack (IA) crew of four, while conducting Initial Attack operations, and, when required, hotline fire line suppression activities on sustained action wildland fire operation. The Crew Leader is also responsible for proper use, care, and maintenance of standard wildland firefighting equipment, and the use of standard techniques while safely engaging in wildland fire suppression activities. The Crew Leader is also responsible for minor building and grounds maintenance at the home base.

Education and Experience:

Typically, the above qualifications would be attained by extensive fire line experience and on the job training;

Minimum Grade 10, with skills to read, write and comprehend wildland fire knowledge and the ability to understand written instructions.

Initial Attack (IA) Crew Leader Training Course or ability to gain certification as an Initial Attack Crew Leader through the Training Course, Incident Commander Course, Experience on at least 5 IA or sustained Action Wildfires, and/or minimum of or 2 years as Wildland Crew Member, and/or 1-year supervisor experience on wildland fires.

Demonstrates an aptitude for organization, supervision and communications.
