## **Role: Exploration Geologist**

### **Position**

We are looking for a full-time **Exploration Geologist**. The role will be based at the Minto mine, which is a camp-based operation with a two-week on/two-week off rotation.

### **Qualification and Experience:**

- Minimum 5 years of work experience in mineral exploration;
- Minimum bachelor's degree in Geology, Earth Sciences, Post-graduate degree, an asset;
- Eligibility for enrollment as a Professional Geoscientist is required; registered as Geologist in Training or Professional Geologist;
- Experience in Leapfrog, ArcGIS, QGIS and SQL database;
- Experience in field mapping, logging of diamond drilling program, and organizing drill logistics;
- Solid knowledge of geological settings, deposit models, and ore forming processes;
- Solid knowledge of copper deposits, and copper minerals;
- Physically fit to perform the duties of the position;
- Must possess a valid driver's licence;

- A demonstrated commitment to safety, environment, and community;
- Self-motivated and able to perform and communicate effectively within a dynamic and evolving environment;
- Ability to work with a diverse cross-cultural workforce;
- Strong analytical and problem-solving abilities.

### **The Opportunity:**

Reporting to the Exploration Manager, the successful candidate will be responsible for carrying out a variety of geology assignments and assisting in multiple aspects of the exploration programs, including:

### **Primary Responsibilities**

- Participate in Daily Safety Meetings when onsite and comply with all Health, Safety, and Environmental Regulations, Corporate Policies and Procedures;
  - Collection and interpretation of geological data from exploration programs including diamond drilling, geophysical surveying, and soil sampling;
  - Contribute to exploration work programs and exploration planning;
  - Conduct daily drill visits for hole shutdowns, drill moves, collar set-up/take down;
  - Inspect and monitor geology at the drill;
  - Assist in drill core logging when required;
  - 3D modelling exploration results;
  - Carry out desktop compilation and interpretation of historical and ongoing exploration results;
  - Ensures best practices for logging, sampling, QA/QC, and database management are followed;
  - Attend daily morning drilling meetings;
  - Assist the Exploration Manager with drill hole and target planning;
  - Maintain and ensure that logging and exploration database are up-to date;
  - Update downhole and collar surveys in the database;
  - Participate in other exploration activities such as site visits and local field visits;

  - Be an effective communicator in English (verbal and written) at all levels, including keeping your cross-shift and other team members fully always informed
  - Comply with company standards, as well as Yukon Territory and Canadian federal standards;
