This position is responsible for the effective and efficient de-watering of the mine pit(s) by following established safety and standard operating procedures.

- Mechanical ability and knowledge to safely operate and work around gen sets and pumps and perform basic equipment and maintenance checks
- Task focused and organized with well-developed time management skills
- Physical stamina to withstand the rigors of working outside in extreme weather and wet conditions for long periods of time
- Knowledge of working with pressurized systems, suspended loads and around mobile heavy equipment
- Knowledge of fusing HDPE pipe and mechanically connect pipe, victaulic couplings and punch lock fittings
- Knowledge of basic math skills and calculations including reading a tape measure
- Experience with operating mobile equipment such as zoom booms and pick-up trucks with trailers
- Experience with rigging equipment
- Ability to understand radio protocols, communicate verbally and read, write and understand directions
- Practice and actively promote company environmental, health, safety and operational policies and procedures
- Perform other related duties as assigned by the Supervisor
