A citizen can sign ONLY one nomination form per office (Chief, Wolf Council, Crow Council, Youth Council, and Elder Council). Potential candidates should ask citizens if they have signed any other nomination form for the position they are running in.

A Criminal Record Check is strongly encouraged to be delivered with the nomination forms on or before February 6th, 2020 at 4 p.m.

Nomination Forms must be submitted to the Chief Returning Officer on or before:

Close of Nominations between 2 – 4 p.m. on Thursday, February 6th, 2020 at the Main Hall in SFN Administration Building OR can be given to the Chief Returning Officer prior to February 6th, 2020

As per the Election Act (2016):

- ✓ SFN Citizens are eligible to vote if they are 18 years of age as of the date of the election

In addition to the Election Poll, the following voting methods will be used in this election:

- **SPECIAL BALLOT** – a special ballot is available where an elector is unable to attend at a poll, that person may cast his or her vote by special ballot in accordance with the procedures established by the Chief Returning Officer, provided the secrecy of ballot is maintained.
- **MAIL-IN BALLOT** – a mail-in ballot will be mailed out to an elector outside of Pelly Crossing & Whitehorse to cast his or her vote by mail-in ballot, provided the secrecy of ballot is maintained.
